

# Magnetglaze Double Glazing

Magnetglaze comprises two strips – one metal (white), the other magnetic (black).

The white metal strip has self-adhesive tape on one side. This strip is placed on the window frame around the area to be glazed.

The black magnetic strip is also self-adhesive and is placed around the edges of your new cut to size pane.

Magnetglaze is intended for internal use only, fitting to the main window frame and not to opening windows.

## Helpful Hints

For windows 1200mm x 1200mm or bigger we strongly recommend placing a couple of screws under the glazing pane to support the sheet. This will prevent the sheet from slipping down and becoming detached.

## Tools Required

Tape measure, pencil and a strong pair of scissors.

## Step by Step Fitting Guide

1. Remove magnet strips from packaging and begin by cutting and sticking the black magnetic strip to each edge of the new cut to size pane.
2. Now hold the pane to the window frame so that it overlaps equally on each edge.
3. Draw a pencil around the pane on the frame.
4. Cut and fit the white metal strip to the window frame, sticking it inside just the pencil marks.
5. Place the glazing pane to the window and click into place

Please Note – it is always best to remove double glazing in summer to allow ventilation.
